Mad Money Grants: CPW Application Cycle

The Mad Money Grants: CPW is a source of funding for Campus Preview Weekend (CPW) events made available through the Senior Gift Challenge. This is a one-time grant between \$2,000 and \$5,000 to be used to fully fund a CPW event.

Event requirements:

- Your organization is a DSL recognized club or organization
- Your event is a CPW event and/or you have submitted a CPW event proposal

Funding preference:

- You have a great idea for a CPW event, but lack funds to make it a reality
- Your CPW event is collaborative (involves at least 2 different groups) and aims to have wide impact or will fill a niche currently unfilled at CPW.

How to Apply

Mad Money Grants: CPW are awarded once per year, in the spring. To apply for funding, follow these steps:

1. Complete your application by February 21 (See below for details).
2. Submit your application to the Admissions Office (10-100) or by emailing PDF to cpw@mit.edu.
3. The Admissions office will review applications and announce the finalists by February 28.
4. Applicants will be notified via e-mail. If your application is awarded a grant, representatives of your organization may be asked to attend an information session.
5. You must complete your project by April 15. Grant recipients will be recognized at the Student Leader Awards in May.
6. After your event is complete, you must submit an event summary to the Admissions office with quality photos and/or video.

Application Information

You may submit a paper application (maximum: 5 pages) that includes the following:

- Name of applicant
- Applicant contact information
- DSL student group or organization name
- Project title
- Statement of purpose and project description
- Project budget
